

**National Honor Society

Selection Procedure**

1. Membership in this chapter is limited to the sophomore, junior and senior class.
2. To be eligible, the candidate must have been in attendance at SHS for a period equivalent to one semester.
3. Students' academic records are reviewed to determine scholastic eligibility. Candidates must have a weighted cumulative average of 95 in the four core content areas: English, math, science and social studies.
4. Students who are eligible scholastically are notified by letter and asked to provide a portfolio to the faculty advisors of the following:
 - a. Verification of membership in 2 or more school activities or organizations
OR be a member of Student Council or an officer/captain of any school sponsored organization
 - b. Verification of 6 hours of service in school, church or community. Service does not include anything for which payment is received or work whereby the parent or guardian is the supervisor. A supervisor's signature is required for verification of service experience.
 - c. Two letters of recommendation attesting to good character (one from a teacher).
5. Candidates must be approved by a majority of the five (5) member faculty council after turning in their portfolios.
6. Students who are selected, and their parents, will be notified of their selection and given information regarding the upcoming induction ceremony and the obligations of membership in NHS.
