- 2. Narcan Training review
  - Dr. Novotny shared information about the district Narcan training. The training was held December 16 as a joint effort between Salado PD and Salado ISD. All attendees were provided with Narcan kits which are now available at each campus in case of an opioid overdose.
- 3. Potential SISD Police Department
  - Dr. Novotny shared that he will be recommending that the school board authorize the
    district to establish its own police force. This will include a chief and two officers. The
    number of officers will not change, but the police would be completely under the
    direction of the district, rather than shared with the village. The board will consider the
    matter at the January meeting.
- 4. Mental Health Professional
  - Lisa Johnson, the district's mental health professional, shared information about her work in SISD. She currently works for the district four days per week. She sees roughly 35 students consistently and currently has a waiting list.
  - The committee inquired about the possibility of adding more days or staff to the mental health program. Dr. Novotny agreed to share that recommendation with the admin team.
  - Ms. Johnson also agreed to compile some mental health tips and information that principals could share with parents.
- 5. The next meeting is March 9. Members will discuss and consider the district's wellness policy and plan.
