




**Goal 2:** Develop and implement strategies to increase security and safety for students and employees.

#### **Thomas Arnold Elementary Upgrades**

- Improvements to the existing stadium to include new concessions, new restrooms, additional seating and turf field
- New baseball and softball facilities built between the existing high school and the proposed new middle school


## What is a Long-Range Facility Plan?

- ✓ Identifies opportunities for more efficient use of sites and facilities
- ✓ Creates a prioritized plan that aligns with community support


